### 13 Review of Act

- (1) The Cemeteries Agency, within the meaning of the *Cemeteries and Crematoria Act 2013*, must review this Act to determine whether—
  - (a) the policy objectives of the Act remain valid, and
  - (b) the terms of the Act remain appropriate for securing those objectives.
- (2) The review must be undertaken as soon as possible after the period of 4 years from the commencement of this Act.
- (3) A report on the outcome of the review must be tabled in each House of Parliament within 12 months after the end of the period of 4 years.
