Retail Trading Amendment (Anzac Day Trading Hours) Bill 2024

Explanatory note

This explanatory note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament.

Overview of Bill

The object of this Bill is to amend the *Retail Trading Act 2008* to restrict trading hours on Anzac Day.

Outline of provisions

Clause 1 sets out the name, also called the short title, of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides for the commencement of the proposed Act.

Schedule 1 Amendment of Retail Trading Act 2008 No 49

Schedule 1[2] provides that all shops, except for those identified in the *Retail Trading Act 2008*, Schedule 1, must be kept closed at all times on Anzac Day. **Schedule 1[1]** makes a consequential amendment to the definition of *restricted trading day*.

Schedule 1[3] provides that approval cannot be granted for a bank to be open on Anzac Day.
