Justice Legislation Amendment (Civil) Bill 2024

Explanatory note

This explanatory note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament.

Overview of Bill

The object of this Bill is to make various amendments to the following Acts in the Communities and Justice portfolio—

- (a) *Births, Deaths and Marriages Registration Act 1995*,
- (b) *Land and Environment Court Act 1979*,
- (c) *Legal Profession Uniform Law Application Act 2014*,
- (d) *Modern Slavery Act 2018*,
- (e) *Police Act 1990*,
- (f) *Powers of Attorney Act 2003*,
- (g) *Status of Children Act 1996*.

Outline of provisions

Clause 1 sets out the name, also called the short title, of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides for the commencement of the proposed Act.

Clause 3 provides that explanatory notes in schedules of the proposed Act do not form part of the proposed Act.

Schedules 1–7 contain amendments to the Acts specified in the overview and explanatory notes for the amendments.
