Road Transport Amendment (Driving Through Floodwaters) Bill 2024 (No 2)

Explanatory note

This explanatory note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament.

Overview of Bill

The object of this Bill is to amend the Road Transport Act 2013 to—

- (a) prohibit a person deliberately and recklessly driving through floodwaters, and
- (b) require penalties for breach of the prohibition to be paid into the New South Wales State Emergency Service Fund.

Outline of provisions

Clause 1 sets out the name, also called the short title, of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides for the commencement of the proposed Act on the date of assent to the proposed Act.
