In the 2018-19 Budget, \$98. 7 million was allocated for transport infrastructure directly to the State electorate of the Upper Hunter for 2018-19, which includes both Singleton and Muswellbrook Local Government Areas. This allocation total does not include funding that provides benefits to multiple electorates including the Upper Hunter.

- *943 FINANCE AND SMALL BUSINESS—CWA FUNDING—Ms Moriarty asked the Minister for Finance and Small Business—
 - (1) The Country Women's Association (CWA) asked the Government to provide more assistance to small businesses in September, and have now called on the Federal Government for \$10 million for drought assistance. Has the Government responded to the request?
 - (2) Do you support their call for additional funding from the \$10 million?

Answer-

The Government has responded directly to the Country Women's Association of NSW regarding drought support for regional small businesses and appreciates the important contribution the Association is making to drought relief, including through Drought Aid Grants from its Disaster Relief Fund.

The New South Wales Government is investing \$2 billion in support for our droughtstricken regions.

As part of this investment the \$170 million Drought Stimulus Package is funding shovelready infrastructure projects in regional areas to support local jobs and keep money circulating around regional economies and so benefiting regional small businesses.

Small businesses throughout New South Wales are benefiting from the progressive increase in the payroll tax threshold with nearly 40,000 businesses now up to \$8,175 better off per year. By 2021-22 this measure will see \$881 million remain in the pockets of regional and small businesses.

The Buy Regional NSW campaign has encouraged metropolitan families to do their Christmas shopping online from regional small businesses. This has been a great success with many of the more than 250 regional businesses featured on the NSW government webpage reporting increased sales following over 367.000 page views.

The Federal Government recently announced, as part of its drought assistance, a new program for small businesses dependent on agriculture with loans worth up to \$500,000 that can be used to pay staff, buy equipment and refinance.

The New South Wales Government would welcome further drought relief from the Federal Government including for drought affected regional and small businesses in New South Wales.
