What impacts will the Government's proposals to privatise parts of the electricity sector have on the affordability of energy for pensioners?

Answer-

The Consultative Reference Committee, which examined the impact of the NSW electricity industry reforms, noted that the NSW Government has made a commitment to continue its strong regulatory role to ensure that small customers are properly protected.

In response to the Committee's recommendations, the Government announced a \$272 million Electricity Safety Net package including an increase in the current pensioner rebate from \$112 to \$130 per annum and thereafter indexed for inflation.

With regard to door-to-door commission-based recruitment of customers by energy retailers:

- (1) How does the NSW Government regulate door-to-door commission based recruitment of customers by energy retailers?

Answer-

I am advised that:

(1) The recruitment of energy customers by door-to-door marketers is regulated by the Fair Trading Act 1987.

The Government has also introduced the Energy Marketing Code of Conduct to provide additional protections for customers.

(2) and (3) The Energy Marketing Code of Conduct requires retailers or marketers to provide detailed information to a customer. This includes informing the customer that they can choose a 'standard' contract with regulated prices, giving details of all costs and charges under the contract and disclosing if the marketer is being paid a fee or commission.

Most importantly, a customer has a ten day 'cooling-off' period during which they can examine the information and choose to cancel the contract without penalty. Customers can seek the assistance of the Energy and Water Ombudsman of NSW if they believe a marketer of an energy contract has not acted appropriately.
