Answer—

I am advised as follows:

The Government has set waste and recycling targets as a priority within NSW 2021.

To achieve these targets the Government is:

- rolling out of the Love Food Hate Waste program;
- funding the Household Chemical Collection program;
- investigating the roll-out of fixed drop off facilities for households for problematic wastes;
- reviewing the waste levy to ensure it is operating efficiently and effectively;
- supporting Voluntary Regional Waste Groups;
- collaborating with the Australian Packaging Covenant;
- establishing a new independent and EPA;
- undertaking illegal dumping, littering and waste enforcement and education campaigns.

The Government has commissioned KPMG to review the waste levy. The levy review will provide the Government with a strong evidence base to bring forward a new waste and recycling agenda that delivers economic, employment and environmental benefits for local communities, and provides greater incentives to invest in new and innovative recycling infrastructure.
