Why can the State Coroner not release the whole body, including all organs, of Hassan Saleh (killed on 6 August 2011) to his relatives in accordance with their religious obligations?

Answer—

I am advised:

Section 90(5) of the Coroners Act 2009 provides the Coroner with the power to retain organs if the Coroner is satisfied that retention is necessary or desirable to assist in the investigation of the manner and cause of a person's death. The Coroner considered retention of an organ necessary due to the fact that serious criminal charges would be likely to follow.

I understand that the Coronial Information and Support Team liaised with Mr Saleh's family in respect of the Coroner's requirements and that Mr Saleh's body and organs have now been released in accordance with his family's wishes.

The NSW Police Force has advised me that asbestos was identified in two demountables on the Wetherill Park police property but not in the actual police station. A specialist company was engaged to remove the asbestos and the site has now been fully remediated.

The presence of asbestos was identified as part of a report undertaken in 2008 and in August 2011 one demountable was removed and remediation occurred of the asbestos in the other.
