### **Public Hearing to Examine the ICAC and ICAC Inspector's 2016-17 Annual Reports**

The Chair of the Committee on the Independent Commission Against Corruption (ICAC), Mr Damien Tudehope MP, today announced a public hearing to be held on 1 June 2018. The hearing will examine the 2016-17 Annual Reports of the ICAC and the Inspector of the ICAC.

ICAC Chief Commissioner, the Hon Peter Hall QC and Commissioner, Mr Stephen Rushton SC will appear to give evidence at the hearing. The Committee will also hear evidence from the Inspector, Mr Bruce McClintock SC.

“One of the Committee’s functions is to examine each annual report of the ICAC and its Inspector” said Mr Tudehope. “The hearing will allow the Committee to explore the issues and themes raised in the annual reports of the ICAC and the Inspector of the ICAC, and to report to Parliament on any matters arising”.
