Please find below information in response to additional questions posed by the Committee on matters relating to Transport Park&Ride facilities.

- **What is the timeline for the trial of the Park&Ride in the car park at Civic Parade, Dee Why?**
  - Park&Ride launched at Dee Why on Sunday, 21 January 2018.
- **Are there plans to initiate any other trials of Park&Ride across New South Wales? If so, where?**
  - It is planned for the trial to include the B-Line commuter car parks (Brookvale, Warriewood, Narrabeen, Mona Vale and Manly Vale) as well as Ashfield, Kogarah, and Seven Hills commuter car parks.
- **Have any safeguards been put in place to prevent people from exploiting the system, for example by taking a short unnecessary trip on public transport, solely to receive the benefit of free parking for 18 hours?**
  - Transport for NSW will be monitoring data throughout the trial and this will input into recommendations regarding the trial, and any potential roll-out to the wider network.
