To Whom It May Concern

ASA being the biggest Sikh association in Australia, hereby clarify the importance of wearing Turban for a Sikh.

1. That the Turban is an integral part of the Sikh Faith.
2. That in accordance with the teachings of Sri Guru Granth Sahib Ji, the Turban is an essential part of Sikh Dress.
3. That in accordance with the Sikh Reht Maryada (Sikh code of conduct) and the scriptures, a Sikh is required to wear the Turban as an article of faith.
4. That a Sikh must not wear any kind of Cap, Hat or Helmet.
5. That a Sikh must not wear any kind of Cap, Hat or Helmet over the Turban.
