To Whom It May Concern

ASA being the biggest Sikh association in Australia, hereby clarify the importance of wearing Turban for a Sikh.

- 1. That the Turban is an integral part of the Sikh Faith.
- 2. That in accordance with the teachings of Sri Guru Granth Sahib Ji, the Turban is an essential part of Sikh Dress.
- 3. That in accordance with the Sikh Reht Maryada (Sikh code of conduct) and the scriptures, a Sikh is required to wear the Turban as an article of faith.
- 4. That a Sikh must not wear any kind of Cap, Hat or Helmet.
- 5. That a Sikh must not wear any kind of Cap, Hat or Helmet over the Turban.
