Question: I did want to ask about Canterbury council. That seems to be one of the big concerns in your submission. Is all of the Canterbury train station heritage listed or are there just certain parts of it that are heritage listed?

ANSWER: The Canterbury Railway Station group was listed on the State Heritage Register on 2 April, 1999. The boundary of the State Heritage Register Listing is the entire railway station including the road overbridge and signal box. The station has been modernised but does retain significant historic elements from the 1895-1915 original construction period.
