INQUIRY INTO WESTERN SYDNEY SCIENCE PARK AND AEROTROPOLIS DEVELOPMENTS

An Upper House inquiry has been established to examine the impacts of the Sydney Science Park and the Aerotropolis developments on Western Sydney.

The Public Accountability and Works Committee will specifically look into the impacts of these developments on planning, land use, public works, employment, the environment as well as transport.

The Chair of the committee, Ms Abigail Boyd MLC said: 'The committee is keen to examine the implications of these major projects in full and understand any lessons for current government policy in relation to these developments and Western Sydney more broadly.'

The Chair concluded: 'These two projects are significantly transforming the area of South West Sydney and local residents deserve to know more about how they will be affected and when they can expect works to begin.'
