# HAVE YOUR SAY ON WESTERN SYDNEY SCIENCE PARK AND AEROTROPOLIS DEVELOPMENTS

The Upper House Public Works and Accountability Committee is seeking further submissions for its inquiry into the Western Sydney Science Park and Aerotropolis developments.

The Western Sydney Aerotropolis development is focused on creating several precincts around the new Western Sydney International Airport at Badgery's Creek, including the proposed Bradfield City Centre, Agribusiness Precinct and Badgery's Creek Business Precinct, likely to comprise logistics, commercial industry, high technology industry, defence-related industries and associated employment. The Western Sydney Science Park is a major development near Penrith which is aiming to create a mixed-use city focused on research, development, education, commercialisation and innovation.

Committee Chair, the Ms Abigail Boyd, said: "The committee encourages key stakeholders and members of the public to share their views on the Western Sydney Science Park and Aerotropolis developments, including any views on the appropriateness of the proposed industry mix for the developments and the impacts of these developments on planning, land use, public works, employment, the environment and transport".
