# Response to Questions on Notice and Supplementary Questions on Notice

## Questions on Notice

1. I understand one member of your board, Mr Binskin, is a ministerial appointment. Who would he have been appointed by most recently? Confirm what term on the Board is Mr Binskin serving.

Mark Binskin AC is a former Chief of the Australian Defence Force and a former Chief of Airforce among other senior roles. Mr Binskin is currently serving his second term on the BDA Board and was most recently nominated by the Hon Paul Fletcher, MP who was the Commonwealth Minister for Communications, Urban Infrastructure, Cities and the Arts and appointed by Stuart Ayres, who was the NSW Minister for Western Sydney and the responsible Minister for the Authority at the time of the appointment. His current term expires on 24 February 2025.

2. [Mr Binskin] is also a board member of BAE Systems.

Mr Binskin's position at BAE Systems is Non-Executive Director Defence and National Security, but this role does not denote that he is a member of BAE System's board and he has never been a member of their board. His membership of the Western Sydney Parkland Authority Board (now Bradfield Development Authority) predated his role with BAE Systems.

Mr Binskin has declared his interest in BAE Systems to the Authority and recuses himself from any discussion which occur at the Board relating to BAE Systems in line with the Authority's probity policies and practices of managing conflicts which may arise within the Board.

3. The authority has had two industry round tables so far, I understand, as part of the industry round tables series. The first one was on freight, but the second one was in relation to aerospace and defence, and I believe it was hosted by Mr Binskin. Is that a role that you would expect a board member to be doing? Is he actively out there spruiking defence and trying to get people from the industry into Western Sydney airport?

The decision to hold the defence and aerospace industry roundtable on 22 May 2024 was initiated by the Authority, approved by the Board and Mr Binskin was invited to participate in the roundtable given his extensive experience in these sectors.

The Authority's focus on the defence and aerospace sectors is well established and is set out in multiple strategies and governance frameworks.

The *Western Parkland City Authority Act 2018* established the Authority and empowered it to attract investment to support the creation of the Bradfield City Centre and the development

of the Western Sydney Aerotropolis. The Act establishes the Authority's functions, including investment attraction.

The Act also establishes a Board for the Authority. The seven-member Board is appointed by the relevant NSW Government Minister, with three members of the Board nominated by the Commonwealth Government and the Chair being appointed following consultation with the relevant Commonwealth Minister. Each member of the Board is to be a person who, in the opinion of the relevant Minister nominating the person for appointment, has the relevant skills, knowledge and experience to assist the Authority in exercising its functions (Part 2, Section 8(5) of the Act) and Board members leverage their industry experience to support the Authority's function to secure and attract investment (Part 3, Section 13(1) of the Act).

In addition, the Authority also operates in accordance with a Charter issued by the Minister for Planning and Public Spaces. The most recent charter was issued in October and includes areas of investment focus for the Authority.

Further detail on the inclusion of defence and aerospace as an investment priority of the Authority are set out below:

- **Enabling legislation:** the Western Parkland City Authority Act 2018 establishes the Western Parkland City Authority [trading as Bradfield Development Authority] and empowers it to drive economic growth and development in the region (Part 1, Section 3 of the Act).
  - **Investment promotion:** the Act explicitly identifies promoting investment as a key objective for achieving economic growth within the Western City (Part 1, Section 3(c) of the Act).
  - **Authority's functions:** the Act grants the Authority the functions of coordinating, securing, and attracting investment in the operational area, which includes the Aerotropolis (Part 3, Section 13(1) of the Act).
  - **Strategic direction:** the Authority operates under a Charter which guides its activities (Part 3, Section 14(1) of the Act).
  - **Focus on Defence:** the 2024-27 Charter explicitly designates defence and aerospace as priority industries for the Authority's investment attraction and development efforts.
  - **Defined scope:** the Authority's functions do not extend to the Western Sydney Airport itself (Part 3, Section 13(4) of the Act).
4. [The Authority] used to always publish minutes of board meetings. I haven't seen that recently, I don't think the authority has been publishing board minutes. Are you able to provide the Committee with board minutes and declarations of conflicts of interests, and also a list of who attended that round table with Mr Binskin?

The BDA has not previously published Board minutes on its website. Due to the sensitive nature of the content of this documentation, the Authority would prefer not to provide this documentation.

5. I understand that in addition to the 2019 MOU that Gladys Berejiklian and Stuart Ayres signed with BAE, there's been some more recent ones that the authority itself has signed with BAE. It would be good to get some details around that.

Please refer to Attachment A1. In addition to the 2019 agreement detailed in Attachment A1, a Preliminary Conditional Term-sheet was entered into in 2020 between NSW Government and BAE.

6. Please provide a list of the 48 MOUs that have been signed with corporations with an intention in the MOU that they might invest and locate themselves in the Bradfield City area.

BDA has 38 MOUs, please refer to Attachment A1 for further details. The general scope of the collaboration for each MOU is specified in Attachment A1, noting that not all of the MOUs contemplate investment or location within the Bradfield City area.

7. What's the reduction in gross floor area that's available [in the north-south transport corridor within the Bradfield City Centre], through that 60-metre corridor?

The 60-metre wide transit corridor of around 40,000 sqm is protected by an SP2 – Infrastructure Zone.

If the corridor were instead a Mixed-Use Zone consistent with the majority of the Bradfield City Centre site a built form Gross Floor Area (GFA) of around 150,000sqm would be enabled.

Once a decision on whether the proposed transit solution/s will be above or below ground is made, the need and extent of the corridor will be reviewed.

The statutory planning framework through the Aerotropolis and Bradfield would then be revised accordingly.

The Authority will respond to transport and land use planning decisions made by others through a review and update of its Bradfield City Centre Master Plan.

**a. How much does membership cost?**

The Authority joined the Western Sydney Leadership Dialogue in August 2024 and it cost \$30,000 for the remainder of the financial year up to 30 June 2025. The Authority is also a member of several other industry bodies.

**b. How many events or functions have been attended by staff from the department?**

Two events this financial year, a boardroom lunch and a media round table. The Authority will attend a third event on 28-29 November 2024.

**c. Are conversations undertaken at Western Sydney Leadership Dialogue events recorded in the register of external meetings?**

For the Authority, only meetings with third-party lobbyists are required to be published on the Third-party lobbyist register.

The third-party lobbyist register records meetings between the Government officials of the Authority and third-party lobbyists and is maintained in accordance with the legislative framework, providing a transparent and accessible system for lobbyists.

Western Sydney Leadership Dialogue is not a registered lobbyist and therefore, meetings or events attended by Department staff are not required to be published on the register.

**d. How are lobbying and influence risks managed with relation to membership of the Western Sydney Leadership Dialogue?**

All employees are required to comply with the Department's Lobbying Policy to manage risks when interacting with groups or individuals who seek to influence Government decision-making, policy, or legislation.
