

**1. Do you identify specific areas as tourism locations and do you know how many locations have hours of operation that extend beyond midnight, are you able to provide a list?**

AHA NSW, by its own volition, does not identify any areas of the state as tourism locations. However, we and our individual members work closely with government agencies and local tourism authorities and therefore accept and recognise the tourist areas as they are identified by, for example, DestinationNSW.

AHA NSW does not maintain a database or other record of any hours of operation.

**2. Do you support the recommendations of the 2003 Alcohol Summit, are you are able to provide a response?**

The control and governance of the liquor industry in NSW has evolved considerably in the 10 years since the Alcohol Summit. There are instances of concepts that were raised during the Summit that have been adopted by Government and throughout the industry.

AHA NSW and our members are supportive of measures which address issues attributed to excessive alcohol consumption whether or not they were considered at or included in the final communiqué issued at the 2003 Summit.
