hi,

in regards to road closures in YUARAGIR national park, on the far north coast, near BROOMS HEAD, NSW.

i am a resident bordering YUARAGIR NP, and am surrounded by PINE BRUSH and CANDOLE state forrest. i have only 3 access points to my resident, some of which get cut off by flood, fire, fallen trees, etc, and i am forced to use alternate routes.

of my 3 access points, one runs through YUARAGIR NP. recently 2 locked gates have been erected along BOUNDARY FLAT RD, effectively barring access over coast range to BROOMS HEAD. there is another track, DOG FALL RD, but has huge bogholes that are impassible by 4wd. the gates were erected without consultation of any of the residents that use that route.

i have a young family and these are effectively evacuation routes in times of emergency. i feel these gates need to be removed or residents should have keys.
