I oppose the electricity privatisation of the states power system for the following reasons

- *It has been done in haste and does not afford parliamentary privilege to company directors who wish to appear before the parliamentary inquiry to give evidence.
- *The drive for profit in an oligopoly market environment will push up electricity prices for consumers beyond the levels that would apply if the companies remained in public hands.
