I purchased the property several years to farm and to build my retirement home on due to the tranquilty and views of the area. The land is of good farming/grazing country.

Since buying this property it is now proposed to put two battery sites within a couple of kilometres of my property. A further battery project to the west of me just south of Tamworth and a three thousand acre solar and battery farm behind me.
