Submission: The Use of E-scooters, E-bikes and Related Mobility Options

Thank you for the opportunity for Woollahra Municipal Council to make a submission to Portfolio Committee on the use of e-scooters, e-bikes and related mobility options.

In line with the Council's commitment to making active transport a safe, easy and healthy option for as many people as possible and meets our emission reduction targets, Council recognises the value of enabling e-scooters, e-bikes and other electrified active transport options to enhance mobility and environmental sustainability. Council also welcomes the existing regulatory and policy measures for e-scooters to be expanded and applied to all electrified active transport options.

However, Council raises safety concerns with e-scooters, e-bikes and other electrified mobility options where conflicts exist with other road users, particularly pedestrians. Past experiences with share bikes also identify risks of hazard and/or obstruction and Council has limited abilities to actively monitor and address what may be perceived as unattended shared transport or electric transport modes.

As such, Council welcomes legislations/regulations/guidelines for e-scooters, e-bikes and related mobility options to improve operation and management and ensure safety for users and the broader community.
