If these are to continue, they need to have dedicated stowage areas, where the bikes are locked into secure, permanent spot, as shown in the attached photos.

These locations need to be financed and maintained by the e-bike operators, Charges for renting the bikes need to start when the bikes are removed from the stowage and ends when returned to a stowage. If this is not considered viable by the operators then their business model is not a viable one.

e-bikes, also, need to be considered as per other motorised transport and should not ber allowed on footpaths, especially the ones with the large/thick tyres. their speed and size are a danger to those walking on the footpath.
