Review of the Modern Slavery Act 2018

This submission makes recommendations about the need for adequate funding of activities and resources to fulfil the aims of the Act:

1. combatting modern slavery
2. providing assistance and support for victim-survivors of modern slavery
3. providing for the detection and exposure of modern slavery

Recommendations:

NSW front line services be required to:

1. Adopt policies and procedures to identify and safely refer potential victims of modern slavery to support and services
2. Emergency hotline for slavery victims
3. Funding for mainstream welfare services to provide access for people impacted by modern slavery
4. Undertake modern slavery awareness training
5. Undertake cultural diversity training
