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The NSW government needs to stop permitting and encouraging new coal mines and gas projects. it is quite simple: by following the next 5 steps.

- (1) The NSW Government should request a specific, dedicated report from the NZC on the risks that coal and gas expansions pose to NSW climate targets, to be completed by June 2025.
- (2) The report should include advice on a coal sectoral target to drive emissions reduction in the coal sector.
- (3) In the meantime, approvals of new coal expansions should be paused until such advice has been provided by the NZC.
- (4) The Net Zero Commission should be asked to provide specific advice and make recommendations on all proposed major coal mine expansions in NSW, as per $\rm s15$ (3) of the NSW Climate Change (Net Zero Future) Act 2023 .
- (5) A Regulation should be created under the Climate Change (Net Zero Future) Act 2023 to place a duty on key planning decision-makers to meet the 2030 and 2035 climate change targets and restrict downstream emissions.
